On Maundy Thursday we remember the day that Jesus celebrated the Passover with his disciples Two important events are the focus. First it was the Last Supper which we continue to celebrate with our Communion every week. Second, Jesus washed the feet of his disciples as an act of humility and service and commanded them to do the same.

At St Francis we honour Good Friday with Stations of the Cross service where we carry a cross around the neighbourhood stopping for prayer at each "Station". We continue with a solemn service of song, prayer, and readings to commemorate the day of Jesus' crucifixion. This solemn liturgy will take place at 10am



HOLY SATURDAY

SATURDAY APRIL 8, 2023 SERVICE: 7:30 PM

Holy Saturday is the last day of Lent. The Easter Vigil Mass, which takes place after sundown on Holy Saturday, properly belongs to Easter Sunday, since liturgically, each day begins at sundown on the previous day. It is a formal service that begins outside with the lighting of the new fire. The light will be brought into the

church to signify the miracle of Easter. We will use incense at this service.



EASTER SUNDAY

SUNDAY 9, 2023 SERVICES: 6:30, 8:30 & 10 Alleluia, Christ has Risen! The Lord is Risen Indeed~Alleluia! We have three services on Easter Sunday. The first outside at sunrise (around 6:30 am) and then at 8:30 and 10 am. Bring your bells and ring them in joyful celebration of this most important day in the Christian church.
